Spice up your wall decoration with panel mouldings and highlight your fancy wallpaper with a custom frame to create a look like this bright blue bedroom.










Pale green wall with wainscots packed together in three layers for a chiseled finish which leverages the height of the walls.








Mouldings applied on top of wood veneers and finished with a metallic tone to emphasise the accent wall. The space exudes royalty.

If you're struggling to add some style to a space try adding wainscot. It's a simple addition, like here just gives a something extra to this pink wall.







Simple white wall trims lend depth to this otherwise, minimal wall while maintaining a crisp and clean aura.







Moldings bring elegance while stitching a unifying look to a room. This space is a stand-out with its antic furniture and accent wall.







A moulding-panelled feature wall with a red that pops.
The white wall in front serves as a pit stop for the eyes.

Sharp, chiseled black walls with tapered corners using mouldings for a smart finish. A bed back fit for Batman.







Use box trim to bring focus onto a particular part of the wall. Often used to bring focus onto the contents: achievements, trophies or even photographs.







A classic French-style panelled walls with a wooden herringbone flooring that brings out the stillness of the space.







A light blue pastel space that is calm, still and also gives space to fit in a photograph or two. Perfect for a side walls.






Painting bold color onto oversized trim can bring that hint of drama to your bookshelfs, effortlessly and keep the space in sync with your furniture.

Visualized here: Kids' room with an impactful accent all, using a mixture of box trim mouldings in the differently sized wainscot.









You can utilize moulding to create a monochrome design that allows you to take a classy statement wall and redesign it into a showstopper.
Visualized here: Rhombuslike structure with one layer of moulding























